

ASAP for Event Review Committee (ERC) Members

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course will demystify the Aviation Safety Action Program (ASAP) and give flight departments the confidence to self-govern their ASAP program(s). This course aims to enable you to become a confident participating member of your organization's Event Review Committee (ERC).

You'll also learn about what ASAP is, how to maintain the program, review ASAP reports, and make meaningful improvements to aviation safety. After the course, you'll have the opportunity to apply what you've learned in a few interactive exercises.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- What benefits does ASAP provides to the organization, personnel, and safety in general.
- *How* to interact with other members of the ERC and run an ASAP program in-house.
- How to submit and process ASAP reports using the VOCUS SMS platform.

DURATION

- Assigned a training license in VOCUS.
